




Case Study: Reclaim CAMISSA


Camissa is the creolized form of ll*khamis sa*, meaning "sweet water for all" in Kora the Khoe-language of the Cape. This river system has over 40 tributaries and springs. Today the river runs beneath the city of Cape Town. Symbolically, Camissa represents **life** because without water, life cannot be sustained.









